

OUR HEALTH CARE PROGRAMME

The charity has an extensive programme of medical care as there is little or no access for our folk to receive desperately needed specialist attention. Our biggest project is to provide dental treatment, whether that be extractions and fillings or can be as complicated root canal treatments and deep cleansing. We work with a private dental clinic and take on average 4 beneficiaries a week. Many who may be in their thirties have never been to a clinic before and they tolerate their treatment very well. Indeed they are delighted to go as it will mean an end to their pain and suffering. On these occasions it is also a chance to take the groups out for a fruit juice and sausages and chips – an unheard-of treat. We also give out toothbrushes, and paste and provide training in how to best manage their dental hygiene.

A similar programme is provided for ophthalmological treatment and spectacles at another private clinic which we set up over twenty years ago. More complicated needs are dealt with in an eye hospital 150kms away. Other surgical interventions are arranged by us for orthopaedics, gynaecology, and general out-patient care. Without us these needs would not be met.
